Recently learners used symbols to label what they could see, feel and hear and they were also very keen to get their hand dirty to find lots of wriggly worms!

Key News

This half term our topic will be **Tribal Tales**. In our World, we will be exploring features of different environments and maps;
Art - Tribal Painting
Technology – starting to control computers by giving them instructions
